_____	<u>Raspberry-Heritage Red</u> – The Heritage Red Raspberry is a large size, very firm, dark red berry with classic raspberry flavor. For many years this was the standard variety for production and high-quality fruit by which fall-bearing varieties were judged. Ripens in July, the repeats in September. They should produce 2 - 5 pounds of fruit when mature. The fruit is good for jam and freezing and of course fresh! Plants are very vigorous and resist powdery mildew.		_____

_____	<u>Strawberry-Honeoye</u> - Rated the best by home gardeners and commercial growers. The very large fruits are conic in shape, bright glossy red, firm and deliciously sweet with a high tolerance to Fruit Rot.
